SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increased Charges on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice No. 859, filed December 5, 1972, requests authority under Section 454, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to amend Schedule No. G-60, Wholesale Natural Gas Service and to file the Tenth Supplemental Service Agreement between the utility and the City of Long Beach as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 13474-G to 13481-G, inclusive to provide for increases in Long Beach's daily contract demand from 65,000 to 68,000 Mcf per day, additional peaking demand from 20,500 to 21,000 Mcf per day, and seasonally variable usage from 915,000 to 1,000,000 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Long Beach requested these increased quantities in order to meet anticipated requirements on its system, and

WHEREAS: By Resolution No. C-21312, dated November 23, 1972, the City of Long Beach authorized the City Manager to execute this Tenth Service Agreement with Southern California Gas Company, and

WHEREAS: The requested effective date of December 1, 1972 coincides with the anniversary date of the Long Beach Service Agreement, and

WHEREAS: We find these increases are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective as of December 1, 1972.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1567
