SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Annual Zoning Reductions on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 636-G, filed January 23, 1973, requests authority under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to place into effect annual zoning reductions, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8955-G to 9011-G, inclusive, on less than statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: The proposed revisions to rate zone boundaries will provide an estimated annual revenue reduction of \$69,000 applicable to a total of 6,949 general service customers, and

WHEREAS: The utility requests that this filing be made on less than statutory notice so that the customers affected might realize the rate reduction on a time schedule comparable to previous years, and

WHEREAS: This filing does include a technical increase in one rate area, affecting zero customers, due to the utility's desire to use a geographical feature to define an enlarged rate area, thus excluding a small portion of territory currently within the rate area, and

WHEREAS: This technical increase will not result in a rate change to any existing customers, and

WHEREAS: We find that this technical increase is justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make the said sheets effective as of February 1, 1973.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1573.
