SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Closure of Gas Tariff Schedule
to Future Installations

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 862, filed January 29, 1973, having requested authority under Section XIV of General Order No. 96-A to withdraw a portion of tariff Schedule No. G-30, Street and Outdoor Lighting Natural Gas Service, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 13500-G to 13502-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The purpose of this revision is to close Schedule G-30 to all new street or outdoor lighting service on an unmetered basis, and

WHEREAS: The reason for this closure is to augment the utility's policy of discouraging the use of gas for display purposes, and

WHEREAS: This closure should result in the conservation of gas reserves but will not affect any existing installations presently served under this schedule, and

WHEREAS: We find the closure of this schedule to future installations to be reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section XIV of General Order No. 96-A for the above tariff sheets to become effective on February 28, 1973.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1574.
