SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Refund Plan

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by letter filed March 21, 1973, having requested authority to place Refund Plan No. 10 into effect, and

WHEREAS: The proposed refund plan reflects monies refunded to PG&E by El Paso Natural Gas Company in connection with previous settlement agreements and related interest, which will be allocated proportionately to all classes of service based on total sales during the twelve 1972 billing months, and

WHEREAS: The proposed refund plan also contains unrefunded amounts remaining from Gas Refund No. 9, with related interest, which will be allocated to all classes of service on the basis of the amount each class of service was under-refunded or over-refunded in Gas Refund No. 9, and

WHEREAS: The refunds will be distributed among all eligible gas customers of the utility under the same method previously approved by the Commission; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be granted authority to place into effect the refund plan filed March 21, 1973.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall keep records of the refunds made and shall submit reports on the disposition of any amounts unrefunded by November 1, 1973.
