SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision to Filed Tariffs on  
Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice No. 638-G, filed April 24, 1973, having requested authority under its Rule No. 15, Section E.7., and under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to revise the Special Condition in Schedule G-13 referring to a proposed main extension to Tranquillity, Fresno County, by extending the solicitation period from April 30, 1973 to August 31, 1973, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9014-G and 9015-G, and

WHEREAS: This special condition, previously approved by Commission Resolution No. G-1562, specified that the main extension to Tranquillity would be built provided at least 135 applications for service with deposits were received by April 30, 1973, and

WHEREAS: The utility reports that it has more than the necessary number of letters of intent to apply but has been unable to obtain all of the necessary applications and deposits prior to the April 30, 1973 deadline, and

WHEREAS: Any extension of time for the solicitation period would be continuous with the current solicitation period, thus requiring authorization on less than statutory notice; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on May 1, 1973.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1578.
