SUBJECT: Order Authorizing More Restrictive Tariff Conditions

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 870, filed May 2, 1973, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to add more restrictive clauses in its Rule No. 19, Rates and Optional Rates as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 13569-G to 13584-G, inclusive, and to make the filing effective on statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: The restrictive clauses added to Rule 19 appear to make effective the intent of the Commission in its Decision No. 80430, dated August 29, 1972, in Application No. 52696, and

WHEREAS: We find these more restrictive conditions are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective as of June 1, 1973.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1583.
