> SUBJECT: Order Authorizing a Gas Service Contract Under Terms Deviating From Filed Tariffs

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice No. 874, filed August 10, 1973, having requested authority under Section XA of General Order No. 96-A and under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms of a contract with United Air Lines for gas service to the customer's incinerator at its new flight kitchen facilities in El Segundo under terms which deviate from filed tariffs, and

WHEREAS: The deviation requested is a waiver of the standby requirements provision contained in Special Condition 2(a) of Rate Schedule G-50, and

WHEREAS: The necessity for this deviation is due to the customer's failure to obtain permission from the Los Angeles Air Pollution Control District to burn fuel oil as a standby fuel, and

WHEREAS: Due to normal operations and anticipated periodic shut-downs for maintenance, repairs and malfunctions, the customer has already made provisions for alternate waste disposal through grinding and/or an outside refuse service, and

WHEREAS: These alternate methods can also be utilized during periods of primary fuel curtailment and have been found acceptable by the utility; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code for Southern California Gas Company to carry out the terms and conditions of the above contract effective as of September 9, 1973.

It is FURTHER DRDERED that the contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution at the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colfornia No. 6-1592 <u>م</u>. م
