SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Rate Increases for LPG Price Change

WHEREAS: LAKE COUNTY GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 9, filed December 17, 1973, having requested authority under its fuel escalation clauses to offset an LPG purchase price increase, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 53-G and 54-G, and

WHEREAS: The estimated annual revenue increase of \$13,171 is effectively offset by the estimated \$13,057 increase in the annual fuel expense, and

WHEREAS: The filing adheres to the utility's fuel escalation clauses except for the late filing date, and

WHEREAS: We find the increase is justified; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 490 of the Public Utilities Code to make this filing effective for meter readings on or after January 3, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1610.
