SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Tariff Schedule Revisions and Rate Increases on Short Notice

WHEREAS: MC CLOUD GAS COMPANY, INC., by Advice Letter No. 9, filed, December 27, 1973, having requested authority to add fuel escalation clauses and to offset an LPG purchase price increase, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 79-G to 81-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The fuel escalation clauses submitted by this filing are consistent with those currently on file by all other LPG companies under the Commissions jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS: The incorporation of such fuel escalation clauses will enable the utility to offset changes in cost of fuel by the utility's supplier via advice letter procedure, and

WHEREAS: The increases in the effective rates submitted with this filing are to become effective more than thirty days after the price increase, and

WHEREAS: The estimated annual revenue increase of \$42,322 offsets the estimated \$42,322 increase in the annual fuel expense, and

WHEREAS: We find that the addition of such fuel escalation clauses will be in the best interests of all concerned and that such rate increases are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454, 490 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make this filing effective for meter readings on or after January 8, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1611.
