**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Contract Amendment on Less Than  
Statutory Notice

**WHEREAS:** PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 651-G, filed January 14, 1974, having requested authority under Section X.A. of General Order No. 96-A and under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms of a letter agreement between PGandE, Southern California Gas Company and Pacific Lighting Service Company covering the further amendment of a contract, dated August 31, 1965, as amended, and

**WHEREAS:** This letter dated December 1, 1973, creates one new point of delivery near Apple Valley to provide Southwest Gas Corporation with a temporary supply of gas by PGandE in the event of an emergency, and

**WHEREAS:** The utility requests that this letter agreement be authorized to take effect on January 31, 1974, in order to provide emergency protection service to Southwest Gas Corporation as soon as possible, and

**WHEREAS:** In all other respects the contract shall be subject to the terms and conditions of the August 31, 1965 agreement, as amended; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said amending letter agreement and to make this contract modification effective on January 31, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amendment hereinabove authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1613.
