SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Gas Service Agreements Under Terms Deviating From Filed Tariffs

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice No. 653-G, filed February 14, 1974, having requested authority under Section XA of General Order No. 96-A and under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms of two agreements with Veronica Development Corporation for gas main extension and stub services at Discovery Bay, located near Byron, Contra Costa County, and

WHEREAS: These agreements deviate from the utility's filed tariffs in that the developer will pay PGandE an annual cost of ownership charge equal to 9% of the unrefunded amount of advances paid by the developer im accordance with the utility's Rule No. 15, and

WHEREAS: The terms and conditions of those agreements are basically the same as two other agreements previously authorized by the Commission on September 12, 1972, by Resolution No. G-1560, and

WHEREAS: It is found that the terms of these agreements will not result in a burden on other ratepayers and are not discriminatory; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to carry out the terms and conditions of the above agreements effective as of March 16, 1974.
