WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 656-G filed March 19, 1974 having requested authority under Section VI of General Order 96-A to revise portions of tariff schedules G-1 through G-41 concerning rates for natural gas air conditioning service as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9249-G through 9260-G, and

WHEREAS: The purpose of this revision is to delete a reduced rate for gas air conditioning service, and

WHEREAS: The reason for the deletion is to augment the utility's long term gas conservation policies, and

WHEREAS: This change in rates will not affect any existing customers presently served under these schedules, and

WHEREAS: We find the closure of this reduced rate to future customers to be reasonable, therefore; good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED THAT authority be granted under Section VI of General Order No. 96-A for the above tariff sheets to become effective on April 18, 1974.
