SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Refund Plan

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by letter filed April 17, 1974 having requested authority to place a refund plan for May 1974 into effect, and

WHEREAS: The proposed plan reflects monies refunded to So.Cal. by El Paso Natural Gas Company in connection with the Permian Basin Settlement and related interest, and

WHEREAS: The refunds will be allocated proportionately to all classes of service based on total sales during the period of June 1960 through August 1965, and

WHEREAS: The proposed plan also contains a refund of over-collections from certain advice letters in 1973 and unrefunded amounts remaining from the company's August 1971 refund plan, and all refunds will include interest at 7% per annum, and

WHEREAS: The refunds will be distributed among all eligible gas customers of the utility under the same method previously approved by the Commission; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company be granted authority to place into effect the refund plan commencing May 2, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company shall keep records of the refunds made and shall submit reports on the disposition of any amounts unrefunded by December 31, 1974.
