SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Refund Plan

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY by letter filed April 12, 1974 having requested authority to place a refund plan pertaining to its South Tahoe rate area into effect during May 1974, and

WHEREAS: The proposed plan reflects monies refunded to Cal-Pacific by Southwest Gas Corporation in April 1973 and includes thirteen months' interest at 7% per annum, and

WHEREAS: The refunds will be divided between residential and commercial customers on a basis of total 1973 sales with \$2,763.10 being equally divided among 5,556 residential customers and \$2,126.10 equally divided among 578 commercial customers, and

WHEREAS: We find that this method of refund is acceptable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that California-Pacific Utilities Company be granted authority to place into effect the refund plan commencing May 1, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that California-Pacific Utilities Company shall keep records of the refunds made and shall submit reports on the disposition of any amounts unrefunded by December 31, 1974.
