SUBJECT: Order Approving Gas Exploration and Development Adjustment Project

WHEREAS: PACIFIC LIGHTING SERVICE COMPANY and SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by GEDA Project Letter No. 74-B, filed April 12, 1974, requested approval without hearing to participate in the funding of the Polar Gas Project and to recover related costs in rates, and

WHEREAS: This project has the potential of providing additional gas supplies to southern California, and

WHEREAS: This letter filing meets the Gas Exploration and Development Adjustment (GEDA) requirements prescribed by Decision No. 81898, dated September 25, 1973, in Application No. 53625, and

WHEREAS: A public hearing is not necessary; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 701 of the Public Utilities Code for PLS and SoCal to participate in the funding of this project and to file for recovery in rates of related costs.
