SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision to Filed Tariffs on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 660-G, filed May 31, 1974, having requested authority under its Rule No. 15, Section E.7., and under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to revise the Special Condition in Schedule G-13, by extending the solicitation period for the proposed gas main extension to Paradise Cove, Marin County, from May 23, 1974 to June 30, 1974, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9261-G and 9262-G, and

WHEREAS: This special condition, previously approved by Commission Resolution No. G-1597, specified that the main extension to Paradise Cove would be built provided that at least 16 applications for service were received, with deposits, by May 23, 1974, and

WHEREAS: The utility reports that 13 applications have been received, with \$9,341.06 of the required \$11,497.92 advance paid, and that at least three more customers have indicated a desire to receive gas service but who have not yet paid their share of the required advance, and

WHEREAS: The active applicants for gas service have requested the additional time in which to secure the additional customers required and to work out mutually acceptable sharing arrangements, and

WHEREAS: The existing solicitation period has already expired, thereby creating an urgency for the granting of time extention on less than statutory notice; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on June 18, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1640.
