> SUBJECT: Order Authorizing GEDA Increases in Gas Tariff Schedules on less than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 891 filed June 25, 1974 requests authority under Sections 454, 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code to increase rates under the GEDA procedure prescribed by Decision No. 81898 as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 13832-G to 13849-G, inclusive, to become effective on July 2, 1974, which constitutes less than regular statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: This rate adjustment reflects the total of the gas exploration costs previously approved for GEDA Projects Nos. 74-B, 74-C and 74-D by Resolutions Nos. G-1637, G-1638 and G-1639, respectively, and

WHEREAS: It is proposed to increase existing tariffs by a total of 0.006 cents/therm, resulting in an addition to current revenues of approximately \$526,000, and

WHEREAS: Short notice authorization is requested in order that the Company may begin recovery during the third quarter of 1974 for costs it is currently experiencing for these GEDA projects, and

WHEREAS: We find these increases justified, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454, 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code and in accordance with Decision No. 81898, to make said sheets effective on July 2, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1647.
