SUBJECT: Order Authorizing a Gas Service Contract Under Terms Deviating From Filed Tariffs

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 892, filed July 1, 1974, having requested authority under Section X.A. of General Order No. 96-A and under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms of a contract with California Oil Purification Company (Copco) for interruptible gas service under terms which deviate from filed tariffs, and

WHEREAS: A portion of the interruptible service taken under rate Schedule G-50 is to be used primarily as a raw material in the production of anhydrous ammonia, and

WHEREAS: The deviation requested is a waiver of the standby requirements provision contained in Special Condition 2 (a) of Schedule G-50 for that portion of the fuel used as a raw material in the production of ammonia, and

WHEREAS: Similar deviations from filed tariffs have been authorized by the Commission by Resolutions No. G-1404 and G-1552, and

WHEREAS: It is found that the provisions of this contract will not result in a burden on other ratepayers and is not discriminating; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section X.A. of General Order No. 96-A and under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code for Southern California Gas Company to carry out the terms and conditions of the above contract effective as of July 31, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1652.
