SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Tracking Rate Filings on less than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 318-G, filed September 12, 1974, requests authority under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to adjust its gas rate schedules and Special Contracts 176 and 186 as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1708-G to 1718-G, inclusive, to become effective on October 1, 1974, which constitutes less than statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: These tariff revisions are to offset changes in rates filed by Southern California Gas Company in Advice Letters Nos. 898 and 899, pursuant to authority granted in Decision Nos. 82526 and 83129, in Applications Nos. 52801 and 54738, respectively, and

WHEREAS: The utility further requests authority under Sections 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code to submit substitute tariff sheets in the event that So. Cal. should make further modification to either or both of its above tariff filings, and

WHEREAS: The net result of this filing will be a commodity charge increase of 0.050 cents per therm increase and an estimated annual revenue increase of \$410,800, notwithstanding any further modifications from So. Cal., and

WHEREAS: Short notice authorization is requested in order to coordinate these rate increases with those filed by So. Cal. Advice Letters Nos. 898 and 899, and

WHEREAS: We find these increases to be justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code and in accordance with the provisions of Decisions Nos. 82526 and 83129 to make the above sheets effective on October 1, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event So. Cal. makes further modifications to either or both Advice Letters Nos. 898 and 899, pursuant to El Paso's October 1, 1974 filing, that authority will be granted under Sections 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code for San Diego Gas & Electric Company to submit substitute tariff sheets to reflect CPUC accepted rate levels, and that such substitute tariff sheets become effective on October 1, 1974 or upon one-day notice, whichever is later.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets and/or any subsequent substitute tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1672.
