**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Rate Increase that Deviates from Filed Tariffs

**WHEREAS:** SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 83-H, filed September 5, 1974, requests authority to increase the fuel cost adjustment billing factor in Special Condition 4 of Schedule 1, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 271-H and 272-H, and

**WHEREAS:** The determination of this rate increase deviates from the formula prescribed in the utility's filed tariff schedules, and

**WHEREAS:** The \$98,500 revenue increase requested will increase the existing fuel cost adjustment billing factor from \$0.98 to \$1.24 per 1,000 pounds, and

**WHEREAS:** The reason for the deviation is the increased cost of fuel for steam generation due to the utility's requirements to burn fuels that meet the 1974 emission control standards of the San Diego Air Pollution Control District, and

**WHEREAS:** The staff estimates that a revenue increase of \$30,300 with a corresponding fuel cost adjustment billing factor of \$1.06 per 1,000 pounds will be adequate to meet utility requirements, and

**WHEREAS:** The staff's estimate is based on calculations determined by the Electric Branch staff as outlined in Commission Resolution No. E-1411, and

**WHEREAS:** We find that the staff's estimate of increases is justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that San Diego Gas & Electric Company be instructed to submit substitute tariff sheets for Advice Letter No. 83-H showing a fuel cost adjustment billing factor of \$1.06 per 1,000 pounds and that such substitute tariff sheets be authorized under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to become effective for service rendered on or after October 5, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such substitute tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1674.
