**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Tracking Rate Revisions in Gas Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice

**WHEREAS:** PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 675-G, filed September 16, 1974, requests authority under Sections 455 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to adjust its rate schedules as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9291-G to 9315-G, inclusive, to become effective October 1, 1974, and

**WHEREAS:** These tariff revisions are to offset changes filed by El Paso Natural Gas Company on August 16, 1974 in FPC Docket No. RP74-57 and another filing by El Paso for its fourth semi-annual adjustment to its Base Rate Tariff to be effective October 1, 1974, and

**WHEREAS:** The net result of this filing will be a net decrease in PGandE rates of 0.011 cents per therm resulting in an estimated annual revenue decrease of \$924,000 notwithstanding any further modifications from El Paso, and

**WHEREAS:** Any excess revenues collected during the period July 10, 1974 through September 30, 1974, will be refunded to customers at a later date, pursuant to Commission authorization, and

**WHEREAS:** The utility further requests authority under Sections 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code to submit substitute tariff sheets in the event that El Paso should make further modifications in its October 1, 1974 FPC filing, and

**WHEREAS:** Short notice authorization is requested in order to coincide with El Paso's PGA filing and it is requested that the reduced offsets and net rate reductions resulting therefrom also be made effective on the same date for simplicity and clarity, and

**WHEREAS:** This filing is submitted pursuant to the tracking provisions of Decision No. 83027 in Applications Nos. 54616, 54617 and 54618; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code and in accordance with the tracking provisions of Decisions Nos. 78468 and 82477 to make the above sheets effective on October 1, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event that the FPC approves further modification of El Paso's October 1, 1974 PGA filing, authority will be granted under Sections 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to submit substitute tariff sheets to reflect FPC accepted rate levels and that such substitute tariff sheets become effective on October 1, 1974 or upon one-day notice whichever is later.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets and/or any subsequent substitute tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1676.
