SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Refund Plan

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by letter filed September 26, 1974 having requested authority to place into effect a refund plan for November 1974, and

WHEREAS: The proposed plan reflects monies refunded by its supplier Southern California Gas Company, pursuant to a refund from El Paso Natural Gas Company in connection with the Permian Basin Settlement, and

WHEREAS: The plan also includes un-refunded balances from San Diego's September 1971 and November 1972 refund plans, with all amounts to include interest at 7% per annum, and

WHEREAS: The total refund of \$814,567.00 will be allocated proportionately to all classes of service based on total sales during the appropriate periods for each refund amount, and

WHEREAS: This method of refund has been previously approved by the Commission; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that San Diego Gas & Electric Company be granted authority to place into effect the refund plan, commencing November 5, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that San Diego Gas & Electric Company shall keep records of the refunds made and shall submit reports of the disposition of any amounts un-refunded by June 30, 1975.
