SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Rate Increase on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 85-H, filed November 8, 1974, requests authority to increase its steam tariff rates, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 280-H to 283-H, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The utility was authorized to increase its steam tariff rates for General Service Schedule 1 in accordance with Appendix D of Decision No. 83675, dated October 29, 1974, and

WHEREAS: The utility was futher authorized by Commission Resolution No. G-1684, dated November 6, 1974, to file a new steam General Service - Schedule 2 with rates 1% higher than those authorized for General Service - Schedule 1, and

WHEREAS: This filing complies with the provisions of Decision No. 83675 with the exception that the decision makes no mention of Schedule 2, thus requiring separate action by the Commission to increase the rates of Schedule 2, and

WHEREAS: The total net revenue effect of this filing will mean approximately \$8,800 annual increase for the utility's Steam Department, and

WHEREAS: We find that this filing is in keeping with the general scope and intention of Decision No. 83675, thus making these rate increases justified; therefore, good cause appearing.

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 491 of the California Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective as of November 19, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1691.
