SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariffs on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 322-G, requests approval of a Purchased Gas Adjustment Clause to be included in the Preliminary Statement of its tariffs as set forth in Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1754-G through 1761-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Authority to add a Purchase Gas Adjustment Clause was granted by Decision No. 83675, and

WHEREAS: Decision No. 83675 further directed San Diego to submit the PGA in conformity with Finding No. 6 of said Decision for approval by the Commission, and

WHEREAS: Authorization on less than statutory notice is requested in anticipation of the utility's need to utilize the PGA clauses filed herein prior to December 2, 1974 in order to give the required 30 day notice to offset fuel cost revisions expected by January 1, 1975, and

WHEREAS: We find that the PGA is in conformance with Finding No. 6 of Decision No. 83675, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 491 of the California Public Utilities Code and pursuant to ordering paragraph No. 2 of Decision No. 83675 for said tariff sheets to become effective on November 26, 1974, which constitutes less than statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1694.
