SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Use of Revised Billing Factor

WHEREAS: SISKIYOU VANGAS by Advice Letter No. 9-G, filed November 14, 1974 requests authority under Section 701 of the Public Utilities Code to revise its Customer Invoice-Statement Form and certain sections of its Preliminary Statement to indicate that it is delivering gas with an 1175 BTU value as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 87-G to 91-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The utility further requests authority to use a therm billing factor of 1.175 based on the 1175 BTU heating value, and

WHEREAS: Authority for such change of billing factor is contained in the utility's Rule No. 17, Measurement of Service, and

WHEREAS: Such change in the billing factor will result in no change in rates or charges to the customer, and

WHEREAS: We find such change to reflect the true heating value of gas delivered is justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 701 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective for service rendered on or after December 14, 1974, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1695.
