SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Gas Exploration and Development Adjustment  
(GEDA) Rate Increase

WHEREAS: Southern California Gas Company by Advice Letter No. 905, filed November 18, 1974, requests approval without hearing of a .098¢ per therm increase in its rate to recover 1975 calendar year costs and under-collected 1974 calendar year costs for the 14 GEDA Projects that have prior approval of the Commission, and

WHEREAS: The utility also proposes changes in filed Rule No. 2(m) and Section H.1. of the Preliminary Statement as suggested by the Commission in Decision No. 83160, and

WHEREAS: The recovery of 1974 under-collections associated with GEDA Projects 74-C through 74-G accounts for .011¢ per therm of the requested .098¢ per therm increase, and

WHEREAS: Such under-collections result from Southern California Gas Company's failure to make timely filings for project approval, and

WHEREAS: In all other respects, the filing meets the intent and requirements prescribed by Decision No. 81898 in Application No. 53625, and

WHEREAS: A public hearing is not necessary; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company be instructed to submit substitute tariff sheets for Advice Letter No. 905 to reflect an .087¢ per therm increase as determined by the staff and such substitute sheets be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Decision No. 81898 to become effective for service rendered on or after January 1, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such substitute sheets shall include the proposed changes in filed Rule 2(m) and Section H.1. of the Preliminary Statement and shall be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1697.
