SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Rate Decrease for LPG Price Change on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: THE SEA RANCH GAS & WATER COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 17-G, filed November 26, 1974, having requested authority under its fuel escalation clauses to offset a propane price decrease, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 142-G and 143-G, and

WHEREAS: The estimated annual revenue decrease of \$977 is offset by the estimated \$977 decrease in annual fuel expense, and

WHEREAS: The utility requests to deviate from filed tariffs by placing the rate decrease into effect on less than 30 days following the fuel cost change in order to facilitate utility billing procedures, and

WHEREAS: The filing adheres to the utility's fuel escalation clauses with the exception of the request for an early effective date and the fact that the filing was made late according to filed tariffs, and

WHEREAS: We find that any lost revenue effect due to the early effective date will be minimal; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make this filing effective for all meter readings taken on and after December 1, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1700.
