SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Use of Purchased Gas Adjustment Billing Factor

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 323-G, filed December 2, 1974 requests authority under the provisions of Section 9 of its Preliminary Statement to adjust its gas rate schedules and Special Contracts 176 and 186 as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1762-G to 1772-G, inclusive, to become effective on January 1, 1975, and

WHEREAS: These revisions are to offset increased rates proposed by Southern California Gas Company in Application No. 55117, and

WHEREAS: The \$1,889,100 revenue increase requested includes a unit increase of 0.2153 cents per therm for Interdepartmental and 0.225 cents per therm for all other classes of sales, and

WHEREAS: The staff estimates that a unit increase of 0.204 cents per therm for Interdepartmental and 0.213 cents per therm for all other classes of sales will be sufficient to meet the utility's requirements, and

WHEREAS: The staff's estimate is based on factors not taken into consideration by the utility, and

WHEREAS: We find that the staff's estimate of increases is justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that San Diego Gas & Electric Company be instructed to submit substitute tariff sheets for Advice Letter No. 323-G reflecting rate increases as determined by the staff and that such substitute tariff sheets be authorized under Sections 454, 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code to become effective for service rendered on or after January 1, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such substitute tariff sheets shall be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1702.
