SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Refund Plan

WHEREAS: SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION by letter filed December 23, 1974 having requested authority to place its Refund Plan No. 10 pertaining to its Placer County rate area into effect during January 1975, and

WHEREAS: The proposed plan reflects monies refunded to Southwest by El Paso Natural Gas Company and all unrefunded amounts left from the utilities last refund plan plus interest at 7% on the unrefunded amounts, and

WHEREAS: The total refund amount of \$16,122.00 applicable to all rate schedules will be refunded to all customers in each rate schedule in direct proportion to the therms purchased by each customer, to the total therms purchased in that rate schedule in the month of November, 1974, and

WHEREAS: The utility desires to credit such refunds to each customer's January 1975 bill, and

WHEREAS: We find that this method of refund is accpetable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southwest Gas Corporation be granted authority to place Refund Plan No. 10 into effect commencing January 28, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Southwest Gas Corporation shall keep records of the refunds made and shall submit reports on the disposition of any amounts unrefunded by July 31, 1975.
