SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Rate Increase Through Use of Fuel  
Cost Adjustment Billing Factor

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 39-S,  
filed January 29, 1975 requests authority to increase the fuel cost  
adjustment billing factor, in paragraph B.2 of the Preliminary Statement,  
as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 184-H and 185-H, and

WHEREAS: Authorization to insert a fuel cost adjustment billing factor,  
and method of determining same was granted by Decision No. 83117,  
dated July 9, 1974 in Application No. 54025, and

WHEREAS: The determination of the 75.5¢/1000 pounds billing factor is  
in accordance with the method determined in Decision No. 83117, and

WHEREAS: The estimated annual increase in steam sales revenue of \$18,700  
will be offset by an equal amount of estimated annual increase in fuel  
costs over and above the base cost of fuel as determined in Decision  
No. 83117, and

WHEREAS: We find this increase to be justified; therefore, good cause  
appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 701 of  
the Public Utilities Code and in accordance with the provisions of  
Decision No. 83117 to make the above sheets effective on March 4, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of this filing shall not be  
construed to prevent the utility from filing future steam fuel cost  
adjustments on the regular quarterly basis, as established by Decision  
No. 83117.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets and/or any subsequent  
substitute tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under  
Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California  
No. G-1723.
