	WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 699-G, filed February 18, 1975, having requested authorization under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to revise a special contract previously approved by the Commission, and
	WHEREAS: Said special contract with Firestone Tire and Rubber Company was filed by Advice Letter No. 668-G, and authorized by Commission Resolution No. G-1660, and
	WHEREAS: After the original agreement was authorized, it was determined that a revision of the original construction plans would increase the capacity of the system as well as reduce the cost of installation, and
X.	WHEREAS: Future growth in firm peak demand will require additional capacity in the near future and the proposed modification would exceed the customer's requirements, the utility and the customer will share the cost of the facility, and
	WHEREAS: The revised contract would reduce the customer's advance from \$81,089 to \$49,745 and the monthly cost of ownership charge from \$810.89 to \$497.45 or one percent of any non-refunded advance, and
	WHEREAS: We find that this reduced cost to the customer is minor in nature and will not place a burden on other ratepayers; therefore, good cause appearing,
	IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of the above amendment to the agreement, effective March 20, 1975.
	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amended contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1727.
