SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Rate Increase for LPG Price Change

WHEREAS: THE SEA RANCH GAS & WATER COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 19-G, filed February 19, 1975, having requested authority under its fuel escalation clauses to offset an LPG purchase price increase, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 146-G and 147-G, and

WHEREAS: The estimated annual revenue increase of \$885 is offset by the estimated \$885 increase in annual fuel expense, and

WHEREAS: The filing adheres to the utility's fuel escalation clauses except for the late filing date, and

WHEREAS: We find the increase is justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make this filing effective for meter readings on and after March 11, 1975.
