SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Special Contract Under Conditions Deviating from Filed Tariffs

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 326-G, filed February 21, 1975, having requested authorization under Section X.A. of General Order No. 96-A, and Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms of Special Contract 206 with Copley Computer Services, Inc., covering service through special gas facilities under conditions that deviate from filed tariffs, and

WHEREAS: Since the facilities are for standby service only, no estimate of annual revenue can be made and thus the total estimated cost of \$949 for construction of the special gas facilities will be borne by the customer in the form of a non-refundable advance without allowing one year's estimated revenue to be deducted as provided under Rule No. 21, and

WHEREAS: The agreement deviates from filed tariffs by requiring the customer to pay a monthly cost-of-ownership charge of \$4.75, which represents 0.5% of the advance, and a special gas standby charge of \$175 per month, and

WHEREAS: The special gas facilities are for customer's gas fired electrical generator and customer will take gas service only under periods of prolonged electrical outages, and

WHEREAS: We find that this contract is compensatory and will not cause a burden on other ratepayers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of the above contract, effective March 23, 1975, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1731.
