SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Refund Plans

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by letter filed April 11, 1975, having requested authority to place Refund Plans No. 11 for gas and No. 3 for steam customers into effect commencing in May 1975, and

WHEREAS: The proposed refund plans reflect monies refunded to PG&E by El Paso Natural Gas Company in connection with Federal Power Commission settlement agreements and related interest, which will be allocated proportionately to all classes of service based on total sales during the years 1970 to 1974.

WHEREAS: The proposed refund plans also contain unrefunded amounts remaining from Gas Refund Nos. 9 and 10, with related interest, which will be allocated to all classes of service on the basis of the amount each class of service was under-refunded or over-refunded in Gas Refund Nos. 9 and 10, and

WHEREAS: The refunds will be distributed among all eligible gas and steam customers of the utility under the same method previously approved by the Commission; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be granted authority to place into effect the refund plan filed April 11, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall keep records of the refunds made and shall submit reports on the disposition of any amounts unrefunded by December 31, 1975.
