SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Gas Service by Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 915, filed April 17, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 and under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to install additional facilities to provide additional service to Tule River Cooperative Dryer, Inc., and

WHEREAS: The customer states that the amount of additional gas needed is 202 Mcfd on a seasonal basis of July 15 to September 15, and

WHEREAS: The customer will use this additional gas for the operation of ten new dehydrating tunnels for the purpose of prune drying and which will be needed to handle increased crops from new orchards, and

WHEREAS: This additional gas will be used exclusively for agricultural purposes and will be used only during summer months when demand for gas service can be expected to be at its lowest, and

WHEREAS: The customer requests that approval be granted as quickly as possible in order to complete his plans in time for this year's drying season, and

WHEREAS: We find that this request for additional non-residential gas service is in compliance with the intent of Decision No. 83819; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code and under the provisions of Decision No. 83819 for Southern California Gas Company to install additional facilities required to provide the additional service to Tule River Cooperative Dryer, Inc., effective May 6, 1975.
