SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Gas Service by Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 912, filed March 10, 1975 having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to install additional facilities to provide additional service to PVO International, Inc., and

WHEREAS: PVO International, Inc. states the amount of additional gas needed is 603 Mcf per day, and

WHEREAS: PVO International Inc. will use this additional gas for boiler fuel, and

WHEREAS: Boiler fuel requirements should be met with alternate fuels, and

WHEREAS: The gas supply situation in southern California is critical and to provide this additional service will reduce service to other similar customers on Southern California Gas Company's system; therefore, good cause appearing

IT IS ORDERED that Commission approval will be denied to Southern California Gas Company to install the additional facilities required to provide the additional service to PVO International, Inc.
