SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Interim Zoning Reduction on
Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 331-G filed March 27, 1975 requests authority under Section V.B. of General Order No. 96-A to make effective an interim rate-zone revision as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1812-G, 1813-G, and 1814-G on less than statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: The proposed zoning revisions will provide an estimated annual revenue reduction of \$4,600 applicable to a total of 604 domestic and general service gas customers in the College Park addition to the Tri-City Rate Area, and

WHEREAS: The revision will correct a rate-zone reduction overlooked the previous year; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1812-G to 1814-G, inclusive be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution No. G-1747 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California, to become effective April 8, 1975.
