**SUBJECT:** Request to Provide Additional Gas Service by Southern California Gas Company

**WHEREAS:** SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 917, filed May 2, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to install additional facilities to provide additional service to Ozite Corporation, and

**WHEREAS:** The requested increase in service of 138 Mcfd would increase Ozite's total load to 538 Mcfd, and

**WHEREAS:** The additional service is required for a new foam curing oven, already ordered by the customer, to be used for drying purposes in carpet manufacture, and

**WHEREAS:** Fuel oil is unacceptable as an alternate fuel because of discoloration and odor problems that would result from a direct-fired oil system, and

**WHEREAS:** The additional 138 Mcfd will be provided under Firm Rate Schedule G-2, and

**WHEREAS:** The customer has incurred expenses in the purchase of the oven and natural gas is the only acceptable fuel to fit customer's requirements; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Commission approval be granted, effective June 17, 1975, for Southern California Gas Company to provide the additional facilities to supply the additional gas to Ozite Corporation.
