SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Gas Service by Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 920, filed May 29, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to install additional facilities to provide additional service to Matko Forge, Inc., and

WHEREAS: Matko Forge, Inc. states the amount of additional gas needed is 450 Mcf per day, and

WHEREAS: Matko Forge will use this additional gas for forge reheating furnaces, and

WHEREAS: Forge furnaces' requirements can be met with alternate fuels, and

WHEREAS: The gas supply situation in Southern California is critical, and to provide this additional service will reduce service to existing customers in the same or lower priority; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Commission approval be denied to Southern California Gas Company to install the additional facilities required to provide the additional service to Matko Forge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the attached contract be marked to show that it is rejected by Resolution No. G-1762 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
