SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Gas Service by
Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 724-G, filed June 26, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to install additional facilities to provide additional service to Richard A. Shaw, Inc., and

WHEREAS: The customer states that the amount of additional gas needed is 351 Mcfd on a year-round basis, with greatest usage in the months of April, May, September and October, up to a maximum demand of 42 Mcfh, and

WHEREAS: The customer will use this additional gas for boiler fuel, and

WHEREAS: Boiler fuel requirements should be met with alternate fuels, and

WHEREAS: The customer has indicated that he currently has standby capacity for 20,000 gallons of #2 diesel oil, and

WHEREAS: Proposed end-use priorities would not allow for natural gas boiler fuel after 1975, thus making present expenses for such facilities impractical, and

WHEREAS: The gas supply situation in California is critical and to provide this additional service will reduce service to other similar customers on the utility's system; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Commission approval will be denied to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to provide the additional service to Richard A. Shaw, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above filing be marked to show that it was rejected under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1778.
