SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 730-G, filed July 16, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to provide additional natural gas service to John Saunders Ranch, Inc., and

WHEREAS: The customer states that the amount of additional gas needed is 16,000 Mcf during the months of August and September at a rate of 320 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: The customer will use this additional gas for the operation of eight new tunnel dryers for drying prunes, and

WHEREAS: It is possible to use fuel oil for prune drying requirements, and

WHEREAS: The customer plans to use No. 2 fuel oil as an alternate fuel but has not yet determined amount of storage capacity, and

WHEREAS: The gas supply situation in California is critical and to provide this additional service will reduce service to other similar customers on the utility's system; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Commission approval will be denied to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to provide the additional natural gas service to John Saunders Ranch, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that it was rejected by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1793.
