SUBJECT: Order Authorizing PGA Offset Increase in Gas Tariff Schedules

WHEREAS: SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION, by Advice Letter No. 141, filed July 3, 1975, requests authority under the Purchased Gas Adjustment clause in its tariffs, to adjust its gas rate schedules as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1027-G to 1035-G, inclusive, to become effective on August 1, 1975, and

WHEREAS: These tariff revisions are to offset changes in rates filed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company, in Application No. 55687, for certain increased costs of gas from Pacific Gas Transmission Company, and

WHEREAS: Southwest Gas Corporation was granted a Purchased Gas Adjustment Procedure by Decision No. 84603, dated July 1, 1975, in Application No. 54807, and

WHEREAS: It is proposed to increase existing tariffs by 2.062 cents per therm, resulting in an addition to current annual revenues of \$988,292, and

WHEREAS: We find that this rate increase is reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted in accordance with the provisions of Southwest Gas Corporation's Purchased Gas Adjustment Procedure and under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above tariff sheets effective for service on and after August 1, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1795.
