SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Gas Service by
Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 736-G, filed July 29, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to install additional facilities to provide additional service to Gallagher and Burk, Inc., and

WHEREAS: Gallagher and Burk, Inc. states the amount of additional gas needed is 840 Mcfd up to a maximum of 105 Mcfh on a seasonal basis, and

WHEREAS: Gallagher and Burk, Inc. will use this additional gas to operate a rotary asphalt kiln, and

WHEREAS: This type of fuel requirements should be met with alternate fuels, and

WHEREAS: The gas supply situation in California is critical and to provide this additional service will reduce service to other similar customers on Pacific Gas and Electric Company's system; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Commission approval will be denied to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to install the additional facilities required to provide the additional service to Gallagher and Burk, Inc.
