**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Revision to Utility Rule Governing Interruptible Gas Curtailment

**WHEREAS:** PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 737-G, filed July 29, 1975, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utility Code to revise a portion of the utility's Rule No. 21 to provide a more equitable method of determining the amounts of natural gas curtailment for interruptible customers, and

**WHEREAS:** The revision requested would provide that for curtailment periods of 48 hours or less, the customers' curtailment demand would be determined from average hourly flow during a period preceeding the curtailment, and

**WHEREAS:** The revision requested would provide that for curtailment periods longer than 48 hours, the customers' curtailment demand would be the average daily unit of demand as presently defined in Rule No. 21, and

**WHEREAS:** The revision will provide for equity in the amount of curtailment among customers of the utility, and

**WHEREAS:** This revision will not increase any rate or charge, cause a withdrawal of service or conflict with any rate schedule or other tariff rate, and

**WHEREAS:** We find this revision to be reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on August 28, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1800.
