SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 939, filed August 11, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to provide additional interruptible natural gas service to the County of Los Angeles for the San Fernando Juvenile Hall at Sylmar, and

WHEREAS: The County states that the amount of gas needed is 434 Mcfd on a year-round basis of which 278 Mcfd will be on firm schedule and 156 Mcfd will be interruptible, and

WHEREAS: The County will use this additional gas to operate 14 water heaters, two space heating boilers, and various cooking equipment, and

WHEREAS: The County is constructing a new Juvenile Hall on the site of a previous facility which was destroyed by earthquake, and

WHEREAS: With the exception of the cooking equipment, all of the other equipment can be designed to operate on alternate fuel, and

WHEREAS: Boiler fuel and water heating requirements should be met by alternate fuels, and

WHEREAS: The County is planning for alternate fuel storage capacity for a 16 day supply of No. 2 fuel oil, and

WHEREAS: The gas supply situation in California is critical and to provide all of the additional service requested by this customer will reduce service to other similar customers on the utility's system; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted, effective September 16, 1975, under the provisions of Decision No. 83819 for Southern California Gas Company to provide 3.6 Mcfh of natural gas to the County of Los Angeles in order to serve the cooking equipment at San Fernando Juvenile Hall.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that authority for Southern California Gas Company to provide natural gas service to the San Fernando Juvenile Hall to serve the boilers and hot water heaters be denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter be marked to show that it was accepted, conditionally, by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1807.
