**SUBJECT:** Request to Provide Additional Gas Service by  
Pacific Gas and Electric Company

**WHEREAS:** PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 741-G, filed August 18, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to provide additional interruptible gas service to Libby, McNeill and Libby, and

**WHEREAS:** Libby, McNeill and Libby states that the amount of additional gas needed is 248,000 Mcf annually on a July through October seasonal basis with a maximum peak demand of 2,880 Mcfd, and

**WHEREAS:** The customer will use this additional gas for boiler fuel, and

**WHEREAS:** Boiler fuel requirements should be met with alternate fuels, and

**WHEREAS:** The gas supply situation in California is critical and to provide this additional service will reduce service to other similar customers on Pacific Gas and Electric Company's system; therefore, good cause appearing,

**IT IS ORDERED** that Commission approval will be denied to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to provide the additional service to Libby, McNeill and Libby.

**IS IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the above advice letter filing be marked to show that it was rejected by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1809.
