SUBJECT: Request to Provide Interruptible Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 744-G, filed August 19, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to provide interruptible natural gas service to Tillie Lewis Foods, Inc., at customer's tomato processing plant in Modesto, and

WHEREAS: The customer states that the amount of gas needed is 5,750 Mcfd primarily on a July through October canning season, and

WHEREAS: The customer will use this additional gas to operate three large steam boilers to be used for tomato processing at customer's plant in Modesto, and

WHEREAS: The customer is actually relocating its tomato processing facilities from its present plant in Antioch to the new plant in Modesto and the Antioch plant will cease operations upon completion of the move, and

WHEREAS: The Antioch plant is currently receiving interruptible gas service from PG&E at a demand rate of 240 Mcfh, and

WHEREAS: The customer has standby alternate fuel capacity consisting of 25,000 gallons of fuel oil, and

WHEREAS: Even through boiler fuel requirements should be met by alternate fuels, this filing will result in no net increase in natural gas service due to the discontinuance of service to the Antioch plant; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 83819 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to provide the interruptible natural gas service to Tillie Lewis Foods, Inc., at the customer's Modesto plant, conditional upon the closing of the Antioch plant. Such authorization to become effective upon discontinuation of service to the Antioch plant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that it was accepted, conditionally, by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1812.
