SUBJECT: Extension of Southern California Gas Company -
San Diego Gas Service Agreement

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 954, filed October 30, 1975, having requested authority under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Schedule No. G-6 and the related Gas Service Agreement with San Diego Gas and Electric Company as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets 14277-G to 14279-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The purpose of these revisions is to extend the existing additional peaking demand arrangements for another year's term, the "winter period" of the contract year 1975 - 1976, and

WHEREAS: Southern California Gas Company requests that this filing become effective on November 1, 1975, which is the anniversary date of the gas service agreement, and

WHEREAS: This filing will not result in any increase in rates or charges, nor cause withdrawal of service or conflict with other schedules or rules, and

WHEREAS: We find these revisions to be reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective as of November 1, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1818.
