SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 751-G, filed September 4, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to provide additional interruptible gas service to MJB Company at customer's new plant in Hayward, and

WHEREAS: The customer states that the amount of additional gas needed is 270 Mcfd on a year-round basis with a peak demand of 16.9 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: The customer will use this gas for direct process, pollution control and heaters in the manufacture of coffee, and

WHEREAS: The customer has indicated alternate fuel storage capacity for 2,000 gallons of sulfur-free No. 2 fuel oil, and

WHEREAS: The customer has an existing plant in San Francisco which currently uses 380 Mcfd of gas and which will be closed upon transfer of operations to the new Hayward plant, and

WHEREAS: This transfer of operations will result in an overall reduction of gas service, therefore; good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 83819 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested interruptible natural gas service to MJB Company effective October 7, 1975 on the condition that gas service to the San Francisco plant will cease prior to gas service to the new Hayward plant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1826.
