SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 743-G, filed August 18, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to provide additional interruptible gas service in excess of 200 Mcfd to Brockway Glass Company, Inc., and

WHEREAS: The customer states that the average amount of additional gas needed is 790 Mcfd for a total average consumption of 2,550 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: The customer will use this additional fuel for new gas burner ports to allow greater glass production during refurbishing, and

WHEREAS: The customer has presently under way, a \$2 million refurbishing program to modify its existing furnace to ultimately use fuel oil for portions of its operations, and

WHEREAS: The customer has indicated a present alternative fuel storage of six days supply of propane, and

WHEREAS: At present the plant is not capable of using fuel oil, and business cannot be conducted at this time without the additional natural gas service, therefore; good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 83819 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested interruptible natural gas service to Brockway Glass Company, Inc., effective November 18, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1827.
